Summer Camp Supervisor (Kitchener) / Substitute Supervisor (KW & Kips)

Description:

The Summer Camp Supervisor is responsible for ensuring overall quality of the experience provided to costumers participating in summer activity camps at KWGC. The incumbent also promotes the KWGC by providing friendly, courteous and professional service, identifying needs, recognizing moments of opportunity, providing value-added advice, and providing the appropriate solution to meet customer requests. The camp supervisor is to act as a leader and assist camp staff in providing participates with a fun and educational camp experience. The camp supervisor will provide guidance and support for all camp staff and maintain a positive relationship with staff, parents and campers.

Responsibilities:

- Active involvement in the operation and delivery of the camp programs, providing leadership to camp participants and staff, ensuring quality experience in a safe and fun environment
- Is responsible for the day to day supervision of summer camp participants including but not limited to during daily activities, lunch/snack time, transition times, early morning drop off and/or late pick up
- Assists in maintaining adequate inventory of program related supplies (craft, outdoor etc.)
- Maintains equipment and supplies needed to run programs in a neat and organized fashion
- Maintains and develops KWGC image and reputation, and protects and develops KWGC's brand via suitable PR activities
- Ensures that KWGC summer camp programs meet and/or exceed organizational requirements
- Utilizes effective listening and communication skills to work with the Program Directors
- Review, complete and follow up on incident reports and report to Program Directors
- Prepare group lists (general gymnastics, KW summer games)
- Assist with weekly staff meetings, consistent active staff involvement on the floor, and general staff performance throughout the camp day
- Performs other related duties and responsibilities as required

Required skills and Knowledge:

- High energy and enthusiasm
- A keen interest and ability in gymnastics
- Exceptional people skills, and friendly, responsible and service-oriented attitude
- Strong communication and team work abilities

Other Qualifications/Skill-Sets Required:

- A minimum of NCCP Level 2 (Technical), NCCP Trampoline 1 (technical)
- Current Emergency First Aid/Level C CPR-AED
- Minimum of 3 years' experience working with children ages 5-12 in a camp setting
- Candidates should be prepared for physical labour of lifting, moving (tables, chairs, equipment, etc.) and lots of walking (very active job)



Theme Dress Up Day!


